

Entry and Application to host deadlines

- The countries who were scheduled to host a club event in 2020 (Men in AUT, IRL, SLO, SLO, NOR and Women in ESP, CZE, CZE, CRO) have the first right to refusal to host the events again in 2021 **by the same clubs**, provided that these same clubs are submitted as participant. The entry and application to host deadline for these 9 teams is **15 July**.
- For all other teams, the deadline to enter and apply to host is **31 August**.
- In case one or more of these 9 teams enter and offer to host again, the other teams in those specific events will be informed by **1 August** that they do not have to send in an offer to host by 31 August.
- All Challenge events, including the men's Trophy I and II, will be awarded after the Competitions Committee Outdoor has met mid-September.
- Only the EHL Cup and Women's Trophy hosts will be announced once the EHL Final8 has been played as the ranking might change which could affect the teams in these events. (**NB** If we know sooner that the Final8 in October cannot be played, of course these 2 events will be awarded in September also).

Entry list and eligibility deadlines

- The 8 Men's and 8 Women's teams playing in October 2020 in the EHL Final8 2019-2020, have the opportunity to submit a new Entry List with 29 names. The deadline to submit this list is **15 September 2020**.
NB This is only for the 8 Men's and 8 Women's teams playing in the Final8 in October.
 - **NB Players who already played for club A in EHL KO16 in Barcelona (October 2019), cannot play for club B in the Final8 (October 2020).**
- For the 12 EHL Men's Final12 and 8 Women's teams, due to play at Easter 2021, the deadline to submit the Entry List with 29 players is as normal: **1 November 2020**.
 - It means that if teams play in both events (Oct '20 and Apr '21), they have the option to change their list as effectively the events belong to different seasons.
- For all other events, including the EHL Cup, the Entry List deadline, with the names of the 29 players, is 14 days in advance of the tournaments.
- The date to be eligible to play in EHL Final12, EHL Cup and Trophy events is **1 November**.
- The date to be eligible to play in Challenge events stays **15 March**.

Clothing

- All club teams are requested to follow the regulations on clothing. Regulations in European competitions can be different from the ones used in your own national leagues.
- For EHL Final12 and EHL Women, teams are reminded that it is mandatory to have the EHL logo on one of the sleeves, without any other logo beside it.
- For EHL Cup teams, the EHL logo on the sleeve is advised to have, but not mandatory. Be reminded that this means; either the logo on all players' kit, or on none at all. It should not be a mixture.
- For **ALL** EHL teams be reminded that from Easter 2021 onwards, only the NEW EHL logo is allowed on the players kit.
